ISSUE(S):

The Northern Health Authority ("NHA") is requesting funding of \$41,288,000 for the Fraser-Fort George Regional Hospital District's ("FFGRHD") share of the UHNBC Acute Care Tower Early Works project costs ("UHNBC ACT" or the "project").

Based on the attached release on November 1, 2023, the Ministry of Health has formally approved Northern Health to proceed with an early works agreement.

The Regional Hospital District Board is being asked to consider approval of cost sharing by adopting proposed Fraser-Fort George Regional Hospital District Capital Expenditure Bylaw No. 344, 2023.

RELEVANT POLICIES:

- 1. Hospital District Act, Section 32(1) and (2)
 - provides requirement for Hospital District boards to enact capital bylaws to permit the borrowing or spending of money to meet capital expenditures.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATION(S):

A total of \$41,288,000 is being requested as cost sharing for this project.

This amount is expected to be requested as the project progresses over a three-year period:

- 2024 \$4.4 million
- 2025 \$20.0 million
- 2026 \$16.888 million (remaining funds required)

There is funding available in the proposed 2024 – 2028 Provisional Budget and 2024 – 2028 Long-Term Financial Plan to cover the requested amount of \$41,288,000.

Based on projections in the 2024 – 2028 Provisional Budget, the \$41,288,000 can be funded using annual requisition in 2024 and 2026, with only \$7.83 million required to be drawn from reserve in 2025 to fund the annual expenditure for this project.

The FFGRHD's contribution to this project could be debt financed if that approach was considered advantageous to retain current reserve levels for future expenditures and to allow for greater investment earnings to be accumulated. Before deciding on the funding approach for the larger amounts in 2025 and 2026, Financial Services Administration will complete a thorough analysis of the options and their qualitative and quantitative factors.

The FFGRHD's Capital Reserve balance at November 30, 2023 is \$70.6 million before commitments of \$7.8 million, leaving a balance after commitments of \$62.8 million. With this reserve balance in place, the capital reserve is capable to fund the cost of this project.

The NHA is requesting capital funding for the following project:

OTHER CONSIDERATION(S):

The Ministry of Health has formally approved Northern Health to proceed with the Early Works for the proposed UHNBC ACT as identified in the Business Plan. The Early Works is intended to prepare the UHNBC campus for construction of the ACT and to minimize risk and complexity for proponents by getting this necessary work done in advance.

The approval included:

- Relocation of the services in the Public Health and Community Services Building
- The decanting, abatement, and demolition of the Public Health and Community services building; and
- Construction of a 471 stall parkade

DECISION OPTIONS:

- 1. Approve recommendations.
 - \$41,288,000 of the funding will be provided to the NHA over three years (2024, 2025 and 2026) for the Project

Other Options:

- a. Defer adoption of the bylaw for more information:
 - Would delay funding for the Project.
- b. Do not approve adopting the UHNBC Acute Care Tower Early Works capital bylaw:
 - Would result in the Project being delayed to find other funding sources.

COMMENTS:

If the Regional Hospital District Board supports the funding request, adoption of Fraser-Fort George Regional Hospital District Capital Expenditure Bylaw No. 344, 2023 would be in order.
