This Bylaw converted the Regional Grants-in-Aid function under Supplementary Letters Patent to an establishe service. Under this Service, grants are provided to organizations serving the Regional District as a whole that have the potentiat or affect the positive identity of culture, community spirit, and quality leisure experiences, and encourage co-ordinatio and co-operation amongst regional organizations and agencies. Funding for reconciliation initiatives is also funde through this budget. The Regional District provides funding commitments to the Two Rivers Art Gallery and the Whistle Stop Gallery as pa of the Regional Cultural Plan.
