Project Status

Acute Care Tower

- On August 6, 2024 Government approved the Northern Health Authority (NHA)
 Business Plan for the new University Hospital of Northern British Columbia
 (UHNBC) Acute Care Tower (the Project) with a project budget of \$1,579.5
 million.
- On August 08, 2024 Minster Adrian Dix announced approval of the business plan for a new patient-care tower at the University Hospital of Northern British Columbia (UHNBC).
- Request for Qualification (RFQ) is posted on February 3, 2025

Early Works

- Construction on the new parkade is ongoing and substantial completion is expected to occur in mid-October 2025.
- Functional program and planning for Health Unit program components is completed. Project is executed by CITZ Services. Targeted delivery is June 2026. Agreement signed with CITZ services to demolish the NIHU building.

Construction

- PCL Constructors is contractor for Parkade and progressing well.
- Tenant improvements of retained space for NIHU project is executed by CITZ Services.

Scope:

The scope of the Acute Care Tower Project, see Table 5, along with the Early Works, reflects the Project scope. Northern Health did not change the scope of the Project in the business plan update, as per the approval letter.


