The Shell-Glen Volunteer Firefighter Association assists the Shell-Glen Fire/Rescue department to obtain funding for items outside of the department budget. Due to the continued budget challenges with saving for new apparatus and capital saving the Fire Department relies heavily on the Association to obtain grants and funding. In this application we are including 2 options for pump replacement

This grant would be used to replace a hydraulic pump used to power our auto-extrication equipment used for EMBC road rescue, and rescue inside our service area. We experienced a challenge during an extrication where the current hydraulic spreaders were unable to free a trapped occupant, and we had to use a combination of spreaders and ram. Upon further inspection by a dealer, it was determined that the pump is end-of-life and needs to be replaced. The pump quotes included are sized for our current equipment and will provide many years of life.
