Applicant profile.

The Summit Lake Community Association (referred to as SLCA) is a non-governmental, non-profit society comprising of an independent group of residents of the Summit Lake area. The SLCA is a grassroots community group established for the purpose of maintaining a strong, vibrant and active community at Summit Lake.

As per our official bylaws our objectives are below:

- (i) To promote and enhance the quality of life, including the provision of recreational opportunities, for the residents of the Summit Lake area.
- (ii) To facilitate active participation in the development and betterment of the Summit Lake community.
- (iii) To acquire, lease, purchase, hold and otherwise accumulate both real and personal property for the purpose of establishing, managing and operating a community centre for recreational purposes.
- (iv) To conserve and protect the natural habitat environments benefiting birds, wildlife, and fish plus the protection of the biodiversity of the Summit Lake riparian, watershed and lakeshore areas.
- (v) To offer fire protection to the residents and environs of Summit Lake by virtue of the creation and operation of a volunteer fire suppression organization.

Project/Request Information:

The SLCA is applying for a grant-in-aid for the full or partial covering of operating expenses, primarily consisting of insurance premiums, and utilities for the continued operation of the community hall, which is the community associations only tangible asset. The majority of operating expenses occurred throughout the 2024 calendar year.
