SERVICE RELEVANCE:

The Shell Glen Fire/Rescue Protection service was established in 1991 and provides fire protection to the community of Shelley and area. Fire protection services are provided to the Fort George Indian Reserve #2 (Shelley Reserve South Side) through a fee-for-service agreement with the Lheidli T'enneh First Nation.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATION(S):

There is no financial impact on the fire department for this appointment.

OTHER CONSIDERATION(S):

Nigel Boeur currently holds the position of Captain at the Shell Glen Fire/Rescue Department and has served with the Volunteer Fire Department for seven years. A "New Fire Chief Orientation" session will be provided, should Nigel be successfully appointed to the position of Fire Chief. In addition, the current interim Fire Chief will stay on as a mentor to assist in the training and transition of Nigel to this position.

DECISION OPTIONS:
