ISSUE(S):

The Environment and Parks Standing Committee has four items of business from the Committee's meeting held on July 17, 2025, that require Board's consideration.

RECOMMENDATIONS FROM COMMITTEE:

1. Logging Services - Legrand Demolition and Construction Waste Landfill

The Regional District of Fraser-Fort George operates and maintains the Legrand Demolition and Construction Waste Landfill (Legrand Regional Landfill). When compacting materials at the landfill, soil materials are required to cover the waste immediately after each service to meet regulatory compliance. These soil materials have historically been extracted from onsite burrow pits. Over years of excavation our current burrow area is near depletion. In 2023, an area of future landfill development in the approved 2019 Design, Operations and Closure Plan for the site was identified as suitable for the development of a soil extraction area or burrow pit. The area identified was forested and a license to cut was applied for. Through consultation and discussion with the Ministry of Forests, the license to cut was issued in June of 2025.

Committee Recommendation to Board:

THAT the Board approves a competitive bid process be entered into for logging services at the Legrand Demolition and Construction Waste Landfill (Legrand Regional Landfill).

2. Compaction and Cover Services – Legrand Demolition and Construction Waste Landfill

The Regional District of Fraser-Fort George operates and maintains the Legrand Regional Landfill. This facility accepts demolition, land clearing and construction waste from the two regional transfer station sites, McBride and Valemount, and surrounding area only. To address site operational needs and meet regulatory requirements, continuous compaction and cover services are required. Slope stability and adequate disposal area layout in accordance with the fill plan needs to be maintained. An experienced contractor providing earth works services is required to carry out the routine compaction and cover operations at the site.

Committee Recommendation to Board:

THAT the Board approves a competitive bid process be entered into for compaction and cover services at the Legrand Demolition and Construction Waste Landfill (Legrand Regional Landfill).

3. ES-25-06 - Fibre Recycling Bin Hauling Services – Rural Transfer Stations

At the regular meeting held March 20, 2025, the Board approved entering a competitive bid process for fibre recycling bin hauling services at rural transfer stations. Invitation to Tender for Contract ES-25-06 - Fibre Recycling Bin Hauling Services – Rural Transfer Stations was available on the Regional District web page and the Provincial BCBid® website as of June 13, 2025, with a closing date of July 2, 2025. One complete bid was received from a qualified service provider.

Committee Recommendation to Board:

THAT the Board approves Contract ES-25-06 Fibre Recycling Bin Hauling Services at Rural Transfer Stations be awarded to Environmental 360 Solutions Central Interior Ltd.

4. ES-25-07 Supply and Deliver Two 4-Wheel Drive Pickup Trucks

At the regular meeting held April 17, 2025, the Board approved entering a competitive bid process for the supply and delivery of two 4-wheel drive pickup trucks for Environmental Services Solid Waste Operations. Request for Proposals for Contract ES-25-07 - Supply and Deliver Two 4-Wheel Drive Pickup Trucks was available on the Regional District web page and the Provincial BCBid® website as of June 13, 2025, with a closing date of June 27, 2025. Four complete bids were received from qualified service providers.

Committee Recommendation to Board:

THAT the Board approves Contract ES-25-07 Supply and Deliver Two 4-Wheel Drive Pickup Trucks be awarded to Wood Wheaton Supercentre for the total price of \$115,896 (excluding taxes).
