### ISSUE(S):

The Robson Valley Recreation Centre Community Consultation Committee is currently made up of (6) members, who are residents of Robson Valley-Canoe, and two (2) ex-officio members, the Electoral Area “H” Director, and a Village of McBride Council Member, for a total of 8 members.

In accordance with the Community Consultation Committees Establishment Bylaw No. 2843, 2013, the Electoral Area Director for Area “H” – Robson Valley-Canoe - has recommended the Board consider appointing one new member to the Robson Valley Recreation Centre Community Consultation Committee.

**COMMENTS:**

The appointment of Kimberly Giese to the Robson Valley Recreation Centre Community Consultation Committee will increase its membership to nine (9) members in total. Under Bylaw No. 2843, 2013, Community Consultation Committees for recreation centres shall be comprised of not more than seven (7) residents of the service area associated with the committee, but not less than three (3), exclusive of ex-officio members. If appointed, Kimberly Giese would be the seventh (7) service area member and begin serving on the committee immediately and their term would continue until a successor is appointed or they resign.
