


Among other projects, We recently built an equine recreation site and adjacent equestrian trail network on Belle Mountain in McBride.</p>

<p>2026 projects includes 1) hosting a fund raising concert to raise funds for 2027 trail maintenance & 2) 2026 trail maintenance project - clearing 7 trails in the Robson Valley. The Trail Project details are described in the attached chart. The RDFFG grant would allow us to hire a qualified, certified, & registered trail crew to hand brush 3 important access trails on the Belle Mountain trail network that cannot be accessed by machinery. This will free our volunteers to concentrate on clearing 6 other trails included in our partnership agreements. (see attached 2026 Project chart).</p>
