SERVICE RELEVANCE:

Mackenzie Regional Landfill accepts demolition and construction waste for disposal from the District of Mackenzie and surrounding area. The mandatory annual reporting summarizes the development and operation of the site for the period of January 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATION(S):

Budget implications for this service are reflected in the Solid Waste Management (3305) Budget.

OTHER CONSIDERATION(S):

An updated Design Operations and Closure Plan was submitted to the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change Strategy (MOECCS) on April 5, 2024.

COMMENTS:

The annual report was prepared in compliance with the Operational Certificate 100206. A copy of the report is attached.

Highlights of the 2024 operating year include:

- approximately 765 tonnes of demolition, land clearing, and construction (DLC) waste was buried at the facility.
- approximately 1,697 tonnes of commercial and residential municipal solid waste (MSW) were transported to Foothills Boulevard Regional Landfill.
- annual groundwater monitoring efforts continued in 2024 with two separate sampling events. Overall, sampling results from 2024 are relatively consistent with results from previous years.
